NATIONAL NEWS

- R Ramanan, Mission Director, Atal Innovation Mission and Arvind Gupta CEO, MyGov launched the "#InnovateIndia Platform", a collaboration between the Atal Innovation Mission and MyGov, a citizen-centric platform of the Government of India.
 - The #InnovateIndia MyGov-AIM portal creates the innovations platform for registering both grassroots and deep-tech innovators at a national level.
- An international conference on India-Vietnam economic ties was held in New Delhi.
 - o Ambassador of the Socialist Republic of Vietnam, Ton Sinh Thanh was present at the inauguration of the international conference.
- Objective:
 - To enhance the economic ties with Vietnam and enable government's Act East Policy
- The National Green Tribunal formed a monitoring committee for Yamuna Rejuvenation Project.
 - B S Sajwan and former Delhi chief secretary Shailaja Chandra has been appointed as members of the committee. The committee has been asked to submit the report by December 31,2018.
 - This decision was taken by a bench headed by National Green Tribunal (NGT)
 Chairperson A K Goel .
- Chief Minister of Odisha Naveen Patnaik inaugurated the Rs 300 crore Rukura Medium Irrigation Dam project in Sundargarhdistrict.
 - The Rukura project, built at a cost of Rs 296 crore, is constructed over the Rukura nullah in Bonai Sub-Division of Sundargarh district.

- Karnataka has become the leading State for renewable energy in India, surpassing Tamil Nadu, according to the report "Karnataka's Electricity Sector Transformation" released by the Institute for Energy Economics and Financial Analysis (IEEFA).
- Almost two years after the West Bengal assembly passed a resolution to change the name of the State, the state assembly today passed a bill to change the state's name from West Bengal to 'Bangla' in all three different languages.
 - This development can be seen as a bid to raise its stature in the alphabetical sequence of state names.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

- Thaawarchand Gehlot, Union Minister for Social Justice & Empowerment attended the Global Disability Summit held in London on 24th July 2018. The motto of the Conference was to firm up the commitments of the country leaders towards the cause of persons with disabilities.
- The 6th India-UK Science & Innovation Council (SIC) meeting held in New Delhi discussed a range of issues on S&T cooperation between the two countries.
 - Dr. Harsh Vardhan, Minister of Science & Technology, Earth Sciences & Environment, Forests and Climate Change, India and Mr. Sam Gyimah, Minister for Universities, Science, Research and Innovation, UK led the Indian and UK delegations respectively.

• India captain Virat Kohli was presented with the International Player of the Year award for 2017-2018 by England's Barmy Army as India concluded Day 1 of the practice match against Essex. Barmy Army is a popular fan club of English cricket supporters who had last year shared a video of Kohli.
