NATIONAL NEWS

- The President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind, inaugurated the Udyam Sangam-2018 on June 27, 2018 to celebrate the 2nd United Nations Micro, Small and Medium-sized Enterprises Day.
- **Udyam Sangam-2018** is an important effort in developing effective ecosystems for **MSME** sector and will empower women and weaker sections by providing training to **80 lakh women.**
- The Government of India has imposed a ban on the manufacture of **Oxytocin** drug for domestic use with effect from **July 1, 2018.** It has also banned the import of **Oxytocin and its formulations.**
- The government of **Andhra Pradesh** has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (**MoU**) with **Singapore** to **speed up the construction work** of its **new capital**, **Amaravati**.

- According to a report titled "Summer 2018 State of the Internet/ Security: Web Attack report" compiled by Cloud delivery network provider Akamai Technologies, India is ranked fourth in the list of top 10 target countries for Web Application Attacks.
- **Punjab** Government has launched a campaign encouraging farmers to voluntarily adopt a new scheme named 'Paani Bachao, Paise Kamao', to check depletion of underground water.

- Mumbai continues to be the most expensive city in India to live in for expatriates according the 2018 cost of living survey by global consulting firm Mercer.
- Other Indian cities featuring in the survey include Delhi (103), Chennai (144), Bengaluru (170), with Kolkata (182) being the least expensive Indian city.
- Hong Kong is ranked as the world's costliest city to live in for expatriates, followed by Tokyo, Zurich, Singapore, and Seoul.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

- The **15th India-Australia** Joint Ministerial Commission (**JMC**) was held in Canberra, Australia.
- The United Arab Emirates (UAE) based carrier Emirates Airline has launched a joint project with US Crop One Holdingsto build the world's

largest vertical farming facility near Dubai's Al Maktoum International Airport.

- The world's largest multilateral naval exercise Rim of the Pacific (RIMPAC) is all set to begin off Hawaii in the Western Pacific Ocean on June 27.
- The **two-month long biennial exercise** is likely to be attended by **navies** of **26 countries** including **India**.

APPOINTMENT

- Senior bureaucrat S Ramesh has been appointed as the Chairman of the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC), the apex policymaking body for indirect taxes.
 - o He will succeed Vanaja N Sarna, who superannuates on June 30.

SPACE & TECHNOLOGY

- Nearly 10 years after India launched Chandrayan-1 aircraft which completed over 3,400 orbits around the moon, the country is once again all set to attempt a similar mission dubbed as Chandrayaan-2, in October 2018.
- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) will send a rover to the
 Moon in October to research the prospects of mining helium-3 and water.
