NATIONAL NEWS

- Nehru Memorial Museum and Library announced that a museum for all former prime ministers of the country will be built in the 25 acre estate of Teen Murti Bhavan complex in New Delhi.
 - This decision was taken in the 43rd annual general meeting of NMML chaired by Home Minister Rajnath Singh
- Government of India has approved a new scheme to empower rural women through community participation. It is called 'Mahila Shakti Kendra' for 2017-18 upto 2019-20.
 - The cost sharing ratio of the scheme is **60:40** between **centre and states** except North Eastern states.
 - o North East and Special Category Stateshave the ratio of **90:10**.
- Indian Railways organized a programme on Ethics in Public Governance and Launched "Mission Satyanishtha" at National Rail Museum, New Delhi.
 - The objective is to bring transperancy and ethics in the work culture and among all railway employees.
- The Gujarat government launched the 'Urban Sanitation and Cleanliness Policy' for better management of solid and liquid waste in cities.
 - The policy was launched by Gujarat Chief Minister Vijay Rupani. The
 policy focuses on streamlining the collection and disposal of all types of waste
 in cities and towns.

INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

- The ministry of health of Sierra Leone, has confirmed that a new strain of Ebola virus named **Bombali Virus** (**BOMV**) has been discovered in bats in the **Bombali district of Sierra Leone.**
 - o It's not yet known whether the new strain can develop into Ebola disease, if it

is transmitted to humans.

Invest India and the UAE Minister for Artificial Intelligence (AI) signed a
Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for India – UAE Artificial Intelligence
Bridge in New Delhi.
