NATIONAL NEWS

- The United Arab Emirates (UAE) has proposed to set up a consulate in **Hyderabad** in a bid to **boost the cordial relationship** between **Telangana** and UAE.
 - The Commerce and Industry Minister Suresh Prabhu launched a mobile application "ReUnite" to trace missing and abandoned children in India.
- The Maharashtra government has announced a new scheme called 'Kanya Van Samruddhi Yojana', wherein farmers families where girl children are born, will be given saplings for plantation.
 - The scheme is aimed at **empowering women and promoting tree** plantation.
- Madhya Pradesh will be awarded for reducing maternal mortality under Prime Minister's Safe Motherhood Campaign.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

- Asia's first Arbitration Centre specialised in intellectual property is slated to open in Tokyo in September to resolve the growing number of disputes in the region.
- Abu Dhabi, the capital of the United Arab Emirates (**UAE**), has topped the list of "smart cities" in the Middle **East and Africa**, according to a report

 by McKinsey Global Institute titled "Smart Cities: Digital Solutions for a More Livable Future".

- The navies of India and Indonesia participated in Passage Exercise (PASSEX).
 - o Indian Naval ships INS Shakti and INS Kamorta under the command of Rear Admiral Dinesh K Tripathi, Flag Officer Commanding Eastern Fleet, undertook Passage Exercise with Indonesian Naval Ship KRI Madidihang (855) on leaving the Port of Makassar, Indonesia.

APPOINTMENTS

• An **Indian**-origin leading intellectual property lawyer of **Singapore**, **Dedar** Singh Gill, has been appointed as a judicial commissioner of the country's **Uca Supreme Court.**

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

- The four first-year engineering students from Hindustan Institute of Technology and Science near Chennai, Tamil Nadu have developed the world's lightest satellite which will be launched from a NASA facility in the US by August 2018.
- The students built the 4cm 'cube' satellite 'Jaihind-1S' with a 3D printed outer casing from polylactic acid (PLA) nylon material, making it lighter than a medium sized egg, at just 33.39 grams.

• India sprinter Dutee Chand set a new national record in the women's 100metre race when she clocked 11.29 seconds at the 58th National Inter-State Senior Athletics Championships being held in Guwahati, Assam.
