NATIONAL NEWS

- Japan and Gujarat has signed agreements to promote bilateral cooperation in culture, business and interaction between the academia. These agreements were signed during the ongoing visit of a delegation from Gujarat led by Deputy Chief Minister Nitin Patel to Japan.
 - The MoUs were signed between 115-year-old Japan India Association (JIA) on the Japanese side and Ahmedabad Management Association (AMA) and Indo Japan Friendship Association.
- The Government has approved a proposal by the Khadi and Village Industries
 Commission (KVIC) to increase wages of artisans by over 36 percent, from five
 rupees 50 paisa per hank to seven rupees 50 paisa. The enhancement in wages
 will draw youth towards taking up spinning as a profession. It was announced by
 KVIC Chairman V K Saxena.
- Software major Adobe signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship to launch an "Adobe Digital Disha" programme across vocational institutes in India. The programme is focused on helping vocational institutes leverage the power of a free online and mobile graphic design app "Adobe Spark" to integrate creativity and digital literacy into classrooms and curriculum.
- Union Ministry of **Health and Family Welfare** released draft **Charter of Patients'** Rights for proper health care by medical establishments. This was prepared by National Human Rights Commission (**NHRC**). Under the draft the patients have **17 rights.**
- The Government has decided to make the Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana
 (PMJDY) an open-ended scheme and added more incentives to encourage
 people to open bank accounts. The Finance Minister Arun Jaitley stated that the
 overdraft facility has been doubled from Rs. 5,000 to Rs. 10,000 under the
 Yojana.

The Supreme Court abolished Section 377 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), the
1862 law which criminalised homosexuality. The Delhi High Court had
decriminalised homosexuality in 2009, but the decision was overturned by the
Supreme Court in 2013. According to Section 377, consensual sexual acts are
also considered unnatural and are punishable.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

- The Ministry of Defence announced the commencement of the Indo-Kazakhstan Joint Army Exercise 'KAZIND' between the Indian and Kazakhstan Army from 10 to 23 Sep 2018 in Otar region, Kazakhstan.
 - This is the third joint military exercise between the two countries. The second edition was held in India in 2017.
- A powerful typhoon "Jebi" slammed into western Japan. Jebi, reportedly the strongest typhoon to make landfall in Japan since 1993.

ECONOMY

- The Central Board of Direct Taxes (**CBDT**) released its annual report on additional tax from **MNCs** through **219 APAs** (199 unilateral and 20 bilateral).
 - o In **FY18**, **MNCs** have acquired an extra income of **Rs 10,000 crore**, translating into a tax of Rs 3,000 crore.

SPORTS

- Indian shooter Om Prakash Mitharwal clinched his maiden gold medal at the ISSF World Championships, claiming the top honours in the 50m pistol event.
 - The silver was won by Serbia's Damir Mikec (562), while the bronze went to Daemyung Lee (560).

APPOINTMENTS

• Dr.Poonam Khetrapal Singh was unanimously re-elected as Regional Director

of **WHO** for another five-year term beginning **February 2019**. She is the first woman to have been elected to the position of Regional Director for WHO South-East Asia Region.

• The Chief Justice Dipak Misra has recommended the **Justice Ranjan Gogoi** as his successor. He would take charge as the **46th Chief Justice of India**. The Supreme Court of India is the **highest judicial** forum and final court of appeal under the **Constitution of India**.

IMPORTANT DAYS

- International Day Of Charity: 5 September
 - September 5 was declared the International Day of Charity by the United Nations since 2012. The declaration was proposed by Hungary which suggested September 5 as the date of the death of Mother Teresa in 1997.
 - According to the 2017 World Giving Index, the people of Myanmar are more likely to show charity to others than any other country. Indonesia, Kenya, New Zealand and the USA come next.
- National Nutrition Week 1st to 7th September
 - National Nutrition Week 2018 begins from September 1 and will run through September 7. This week is observed in order to raise concerns about the importance of good nutrition and healthy eating.
 - o The theme of National Nutrition Week 2018 is **Go Further with Food.**
