NATIONAL NEWS

- United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) will be setting up a 'Design University for Gaming' in Visakhapatnam.
 - UNESCO delegation entered into an agreement with Andhra Pradesh Economic Development Board (APEDB) for the establishment of 'Gaming Digital Learning Hub'.
- A Rs 250-crore Civil Aviation Research Organisation (CARO) will come up within 18 months at Begumpet in Hyderabad.
 - Laying the foundation stone for the CARO project to be implemented under the Airports Authority of India, Union Civil Aviation Minister Suresh Prabhu said the focus of the centre will be on pursuing interdisciplinary solutions to improve the civil aviation sector.
- In a first, the Uttarakhand High Court accorded the status of 'legal person or entity' to the animals in the state. The HC stated that "they have a distinct persona with corresponding rights, duties and liabilities of a living person."

NOTE:

o In March 2017, the Uttarakhand High Court had accorded the status of 'living human entities' to the Ganga and Yamuna, the two most sacred rivers of India.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

- The Mattala Rajapaksa International Airport (MRIA) would be operated as a Sri Lanka-India joint venture. The \$210 million facility, 241km southeast of Colombo, is dubbed the "world's emptiest airport" due to a lack of flights.
- The **2nd meeting** of the joint working group on **tourism cooperation** between **India and Nepal** concluded in **Kathmandu**, Nepal. Both sides agreed to jointly promote **Buddhist and Ramayana circuits and Adventure tourism.** The meeting also decided to set up an industry-led India Nepal Tourism Forum.

APPOINTMENTS

• Justice Adarsh Kumar Goel, who retired from the Supreme Court of India, has been appointed as the new Chairperson of the National Green Tribunal (NGT). He has been appointed to the position for a term of five years, as per an order issued by the personnel ministry.

SPORTS

• Bajrang Punia emerged champion at the Tbilisi Grand Prix in the 65kg category after outplaying Iranian wrestler Mehran Nasiri in the final in Georgia. The 2018 Commonwealth Games gold medallist recorded a comfortable 9-3 win over the Iranian.
