NATIONAL NEWS

• After Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh Government is all set to ban the use of plastic and thermocol cutlery in the state.

MY

- The Global Innovation Index (GII) has ranked India as the 57th most innovative nation in the world.
 - o The country has improved its ranking from 60th position last year.
 - o India has been improving steadily since it was ranked 81st in 2015.
 - o **Switzerland** ranked for 8th straight year.
- Microsoft India has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Rajasthan government to improve the integration of technology in teaching and skilling of students and educators in government colleges.
- Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP), Ministry of Commerce and Industry, released the final rankings of States in Ease of Doing Business in New Delhi.
 - The top rankers are Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and Haryana.
 Jharkhand and Gujarat stood fourth and fifth respectively.
 - o Tamil Nadu has 15th position for ease of doing business.
- Union Minister for Chemicals & Fertilizers and Parliamentary Affairs, Shri Ananthkumar inaugurated the CIPET: Centre for Skilling & Technical Support (CSTS) at ITI Building and laid the foundation stone of new Central Institute of Plastics Engineering & Technology (CIPET) Building at Doiwala, Dehradun.

- o CIPET: CSTS, **Dehradun is the 32nd CIPET** centre in the country.
- India has become the world's sixth-biggest economy, pushing France into seventh place, according to updated World Bank figures for 2017.
- India's gross domestic product (GDP) amounted to \$2.597 trillion at the end of 2017, against \$2.582 trillion for France.
 - o The world's top 3 economies are:
 - o The United States,
 - o China,
 - o Japan.
- The India-Korea Technology Exchange Centre was inaugurated by the Minister of State (I/C) MSME Giriraj Singh and Minister of SMEs and Start-ups of Republic of Korea, Hong Jong- hak in New Delhi.
