National News

- Union Minister for Women and Child Development Maneka Gandhi and Minister of State for Home Hansraj Ahir has jointly launched a handbook titled "Legal Processes for the Police in Respect of Crime Against Children" on ways to prevent crimes against children.
- Goa Revolution Day was celebrated on June 18 in the state to pay tributes to the martyrs of the state's liberation struggle.
 - The revolutionary call provided a spark to Goa's freedom struggle and the state was finally liberated on 19th December, 1961.
