• Surajkund International Crafts Mela-2019

• Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Mandhan

 The Union Finance Minister Piyush Goyal announced the Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Mandhan scheme in the interim budget 2019 for workers in the unorganized sector.

About the scheme

- o The features of the Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Mandhan scheme are:
- o Under the scheme, an assured monthly pension of Rs. 3,000 per month will be provided to workers in the unorganized sector after 60 years of age.
- o To avail of the scheme, workers will have to contribute a minimal Rs. 100 month per month.
- o The scheme is expected to benefit 10 crore workers.
- This new pension scheme will run alongside the existing Atal Pension Yojana, which guarantees returns post-retirement.
- PM inaugurates Railway electrification of 294-km long Andal-Sainthia-Pakur-Malda and khana-Sainthia Sections in West Bengal
 - On 2nd February 2019, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated Railway electrification of 294-km long Andal-Sainthia-Pakur-Malda and khana-Sainthia sections in West Bengal.
 - Key Points
 - The electrification of 294-km sections will make the transportation of coal and stone chips to North and North East India fast and convenient.
 - The 20-km long Hijli-Narayangarh third line was also inaugurated by Prime Minister, Narendra Modi.
 - o Pirme Minister Narendra Modi announced various schemes has been launched in this year's budget that will benefit more than 12 crore families of small farmers, 30-40 crore workers and 3 crore middle-class families.

 (Instrument in Support of Trade Exercise) was launched by the governments of
 United Kingdom, France and Germany.
- The Special payment system, INSTEX will save Iran nuclear Deal by allowing Iran to keep trading with countries of European Union despite of sanctions reimposed by USA.
- o INSTEX has supervisory board chaired by UK with members from France and Germany and it is registered with Paris with an Initial 3000 Euros.

Key Points

- o Former ISRO chairman K. Kasturirangan unveiled the full scale model of Gaganyaan's crew module in the presence of ISRO's chairman K. Sivan.
- S. Unnikrishnan Nair and R. Hutton was declared as the founder Director of HSFC and Project Director of Gaganyaan respectively by ISRO chairman Dr. K. Sivan.
