1. Which country has improved its composite score from 57 in 2018 to 60 in the Sustainable Development Goals Index 2019-20?

Answer: India

- This has been achieved due to better works in water and sanitation, affordable and clean energy and industry, innovation, and infrastructure. Kerala, Himachal Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Telanganahave topped the list of states on the SDGs Index-2019-20. Related Keys
